Start // Phnompenh / Battambang / Siem Reap / Kampong Thom / Phnom Penh / Finish //

Discover the highlights of Cambodia on this whirlwind tour. Learn about the country's turbulent past as you visit the Killing Fields and Genocide Museum, before visiting the largest religious complex in the world, Angkor Wat. Combining unique floating markets, friendly locals and colourful cultures this short tour packs in the highlights of three diverse countries.



DAY 1: PHNOM PENH ARRIVAL

Accommodation: Sun & Moon Urban Hotel

Visit the National Museum, home to the world's best and probably the largest collections of Khmer art. You will then visit the Royal Palace and the attached Silver Pagoda. Overnight in Phnom Penh

DAY 2: PHNOM PENH, "KILLING FIELDS"

Accommodation: Sun & Moon Urban Hotel

In the morning, you will visit the Tuol Sleng Museum, which was originally built as a secondary school named Tuol Svay Prey High School in 1960, then the Khmer Rouge converted this into a torture and interrogation centre to extract 'confessions' of anti-government sentiment. After that, you will visit the so-called 'Killing Fields' or the Choeung Ek Execution, the exhumed skulls of some 8,000 souls, arranged by sex and age, are displayed behind glass panels in the Memorial Stupa, which was erected in 1988. After that, drive back and spend the night in Phnom Penh.

DAY 3: PHNOM PENH, DRIVE TO BATTAMBANG

Accommodation: Bambu Resort

Visit the "Vihara of the 18-Cubit Buddha". Continue towards Kampong Chhnang province and stop at Kompong Tralach Leu Pagoda. Overnight in Battambang

DAY 4: BATTAMBANG

Accommodation: Bambu Resort

After breakfast at hotel, you will

drive to the Phnom Bannan Hill and climb the 337 steps to reach the temple. In the afternoon, visit the Wat Ek Phnom, a nice 11th century temple which offers a very peaceful atmosphere in the countryside. Spend the night in Battambang.

DAY 5: BATTAMBANG, BOAT TO SIEM REAP

Accommodation: Tara Angkor Hotel

This morning, you will board a private speedboat from Battambang to Siem Reap in the Tonle Sap Lake. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 6: SIEM REAP: ANGKOR TEMPLE

Accommodation: Tara Angkor Hotel

After breakfast, you'll begin with a visit to Angkor Thom, starting with the Bayon, a bizarre structure of several architectural changes reflecting



a switch from Hinduism to Buddhism. You'll then visit Ta Prohm, strangled by massive tree roots. In the afternoon, you'll explore Angkor Wat itself. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 7: BANTEY SREI, ROLOUS GROUP

Accommodation: Tara Angkor Hotel

In the morning, you will visit a famous temple of Bantey Srey "the Citadel of Women". After that, transfer to visit the Roluos Group, the 'Chantiers Ecoles - Les Artisans d'Angkor' which provides training to young Cambodians in an effort to

revive the ancient Khmer traditions of stone carving and wood sculpting. You will spend the night in Siem Reap.

DAY 8: SIEM REAP, SAMBOR PREI KUK, KAMPONG THOM

Accommodation: Sambor Village

After breakfast at hotel, you will drive to Kampong Thom, visit the ancient capital of Chenla with its 100 temples dating back to the Pre-Angkorian period. Overnight in Kampong Thom.

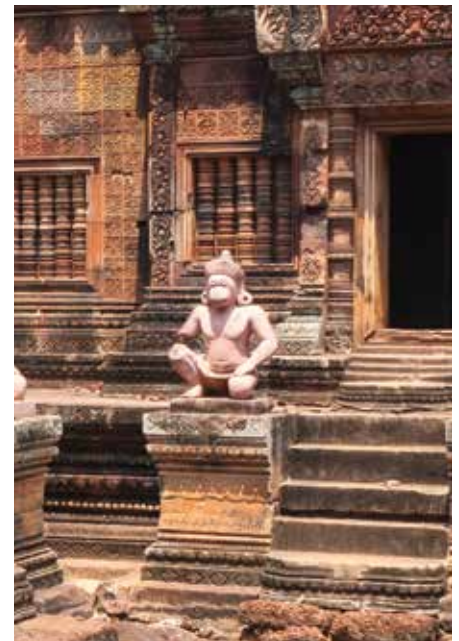
DAY 9: KAMPONG THOM, KAMPONG CHAM, PHNOM PENH

Accommodation: Sun & Moon Urban Hotel

Visit Phum Brasat and Wat Koha Norkor on the way.

DAY 10: PHNOM PENH DEPARTURE

Breakfast at hotel. Free time until transferred to the airport for departure flight.
