Headline monuments aside, Angkor has an extraordinary wealth of attractions. Literally hundreds of major temple complexes dot the countryside hereabouts, spread over an area of some four hundred square kilometres, and for many visitors it's at these lesser-known destinations that the true spirit and magic of Angkor can still be found.



DAY 3: SIEM REAP DEPARTURE

Your day will be taken up with visits to some of the outer sites including Preah Khan, a huge and highly explorable monastic complex, Neak Pean, a Himalayan-style lake and sanctuary, and East Mebon, a temple-mountain. After lunch, you'll also see Ta Prohm, strangled by massive tree roots and typical of the condition of the whole complex when it was discovered in 1860 by French naturalist Henri Mouhot. Your guide will then show you the Prasat Kravan (also known as the Cardomom Sanctuary) and Srah Srang lake and landing terrace. Then through to Siem Reap airport for your departure flight.

DAY 1: SIEM REAP ARRIVAL

Accommodation: Tara Angkor Hotel

Upon arrival Siem Reap Airport, pick up and transfer hotel for check in. Overnight at hotel in Siem Reap.

DAY 2: SIEM REAP, ANGKOR TEMPLE

Accommodation: Tara Angkor Hotel

After breakfast, visit the antique capital of Angkor Thom: the South Gate, the Bayon with 54 towers, each carved with four faces of the compassionate Boddhisattva, the

nearby temple-mountain of Baphuon, the Royal Enclosure with the Phimeanakas temple, the Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King. Lunch at local restaurant. Afternoon, visit Angkor Wat (early-mid 12th century) dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu. This huge temple-mountain, built by King Suryavarman II, is considered as the masterpiece of Khmer architecture and art. Sunset from Phnom Bakeng Hill, offering an outstanding view over Angkor. Overnight at hotel in Siem Reap.
